Affiliations

WHEREAS, the Wyoming State AFL-CIO lobbies for all Wyoming workers; and

WHEREAS, the Wyoming State AFL-CIO is a direct link to the National AFL-CIO lobbying effort; and

WHEREAS, the majority of Wyoming's AFL-CIO union members contribute to the cost of such lobbying efforts; and

WHEREAS, it is grossly unjust to those who contribute their fair share, while the minority continues to reap the benefits with a free ride; and

WHEREAS, those unions who refuse to affiliate are practicing the same freeloading activity as the worker who refuses to join the union under the so called "right-to-work" law; and

WHEREAS, Wyoming's unions must join together in solidarity if we expect to influence legislation which affects Wyoming's workers and citizens; now therefore be it

RESOLVED, that this 59th Constitutional Convention of the Wyoming State AFL-CIO recognizes the need for 100% affiliation and that each affiliated local union and their membership shall make every effort to assist the Wyoming State AFL-CIO in achieving the affiliation of Wyoming unions in order to bring solidarity and unity to organized labor in Wyoming.
